

Christopher Jumin Lee Featured as Korea Expert by BBC

Partner Christopher Jumin Lee was recently quoted in a BBC article regarding the arrest of South Korea's impeached president Yoon Suk Yeol. In the article, Mr. Lee offers analysis into how the institutional structure of President Yoon's Presidential Security Service (PSS) had led to their unprecedented resistance to a lawful arrest warrant, and expressed relief that the warrant was ultimately executed without any violent incident.

A South Korean native and U.S. trial lawyer, Mr. Lee's ability to navigate disparate business cultures makes him a unique asset in high-stakes, cross-border disputes. As one of exceedingly few South Korean nationals who has served as lead counsel in U.S. trials, he is an integral part of Bird Marella's thriving Korea Practice Group.
