In the piece, Mr. Landman provided insight into the future of the DOJ's focus on hot-button issues, including an increased priority in immigration-related prosecutions, a decrease in white collar prosecutions, and a lower priority in civil rights enforcement matters.

Mr. Landman shared, "[President Trump's recent pardons and firing of federal prosecutors that worked on prosecutions of President Trump] only adds to the growing concern about the new administration's weaponization and politicization of the Justice Department."
